

# About Karazin

V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University, founded in 1804 is one of the oldest universities in Eastern Europe. A University with an over 200-year history is a leading Research and Educational Institution in Ukraine. V.N. Karazin Kharkiv National University is the only university in Ukraine that has trained and employed three Nobel Prize laureates: the biologist I. Mechnikov, the economist S. 

scientific schools and it has the biggest potential and base for training high skilled personnel in Left-Bank Ukraine. Annually the University holds more than 150 international and national conferences on research and teaching methods. The University is a co-founder of the Eurasian University Association and is a member of the World and the European University Associations. In the “Top-200 Ukraine” rating conducted by the UNESCO Chair, Karazin University ranks third among all Ukrainian Higher Educational Institutions. In 2013, according to University Ranking by Academic Performance (URAP), Karazin University ranks 1st in Ukraine.

Together with other major European universities, V.N. Karazin Kharkiv National University boasts its wide international recognitions one of the initiators of signing the Magna Charta Universitatum (Bologna, 1998). The University is a co-founder of the Eurasian Universities Association, an active participant of the International Association of Universities and the European University Association.

# Karazin Medical Simulation Center

an innovative medical training simulation center for improving skills of students and researchers



The Center stimulates the work of the departments of a modern hospital, including an emergency department, a delivery room with neonatal and pediatric units, a surgical operating unit, an intensive care unit, and others. For teaching practical skills, the centre uses various modern manikins and workstations of leading simulation equipment manufacturers “Ambu”, “Gaumard”, “Simbionix”, “Simulab”, etc.

The Center also has an interactive (3D) anatomy table that makes it possible to study the systems and organs of the human body from all angles, both healthy and affected by various pathologies.

This is the first such ambitious centre in Ukraine, with such state-of-the-art equipment and professional level of instructors. The Medical Training Simulation Center is open not only for undergraduate students, but for medical interns, graduates, scientists, and healthcare professionals. There, they can acquire new skills and improve their qualifications. In the future, the centre plans to conduct various certified courses for physicians.



# Global Recognition

V.N. Karazin Kharkiv National University is a centre for international science and education, one of the major intellectual centres of Ukraine. Today more than 5,000 foreign students study here and about 1,000 of them are the citizens of India. We are committed to building a community that is devoted to student success and values in individual learning, growth and service.

Karazin has one of the best Medical Faculties in Eastern Europe. It is globally recognized by the WHO, UNESCO,

Today the University has 21 Faculties and 125 Departments, which provide training for specialists in 61 majors. The University also comprises three Research Institutes (of Astronomy, Biology and Chemistry), Central Scientific Library with over 3.5 million books in its stocks, Botanical Garden, University History Museum, Museum of Natural History, Museum of Archeology and Ethnography.

The total University enrollment, including the students of the Center for Training International Students and the Center for Professional Education, amounts to about 15,000 undergraduate and graduate students and about 400 postgraduate students. The University employs up to 1,500 faculty and research staff, including more than 200 doctors of sciences, full professors, and almost 800 PhDs, associate professors.

Karazin Kharkiv National University offers 115 majors and minors, covering the whole scope of modern classical university education.

# International Department



V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University is involved in extensive international cooperation and is an active member of the international community of the leading European and world universities. It cooperates with more than 180 partners all over the world.

Together with other major European universities, in 1988 Kharkiv National University signed the Great University Charter that initiated the Bologna Process.

Kharkiv University started training international students in 1948 as the University introduced the education of

foreign students in English Medium. Nowadays the University currently enrolls more than 5000 international students from 80 countries.

The International Students Council will solve the relevant issues and problems related to the educational process, protect the rights and interests of the international students enrolled in the University, promote meeting



their proper needs in education, life, health, recreation, etc. The activity of the department is also aimed at ensuring active academic mobility of students, postgraduate students, candidates for doctor's degree, professorial and pedagogical staff of the university.

Besides, the department gathers and processes information on the activity of international funds and institutions which provide grants and scholarships for Ukrainian scholars and students.

# Ukrainian-Indian Academic Center




Ukraine's second-biggest city does not look provincial, and for good reason: for over 15 years, from 1919 to 1934, it was the Ukrainian capital. That is one of the reasons why Kharkiv's scientific and cultural levels are so high (and its industrial level, too). The city is famous for its educational institutions. Kharkiv is a modern city with a 1.5 million population. It was founded in 1654 and is a large industrial, scientific, educational, commercial and transport centre of Ukraine.

Kharkiv's climate is humid continental with cold and snowy winters and hot summers. The seasonal average temperatures are not too cold in winter, not too hot in summer:  $-6.9^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $19.6^{\circ}\text{F}$ ) in January and  $+20.3^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $68.54^{\circ}\text{F}$ ) in July. The average rainfall totals 513 mm (20 in) per year, with the most in June and July.

The old centre of Kharkiv is located around University Hill; named for the Kharkiv Imperial University, which

started life in 1805 (today it is known as the Kharkiv National University). The city also boasts the Kharkiv Polytechnic Institute, the Kharkiv National University of



Radio and other educational institutions. In addition to the 45 universities in Kharkiv, there are 60 scientific research institutions, 16 museums, the city art gallery, 6 public theatres, 80 libraries and the country's oldest observatory. Such are the facts that confirm Kharkiv's status as Ukraine's academic and scientific capital.

Kharkiv is located at the intersection of four rivers (Kharkiv, Lopan, Udy, Nemyshlia). The gem of Kharkiv is Maxim Gorky Central Park for Culture and Recreation, one of the 15 best entertainment grounds in Europe, according to the famous travel portal Tripadvisor.


